Carbon neutral operation

A step-by-step overview of how we create carbon neutral operations

1

To address our operational emissions, the Autex in-house sustainability team annually measures our Greenhouse Gas (GHG) emissions of all global Autex organisations.

2

Carbon accounting is undertaken in accordance with ISO 14064-1 which specifies principles and requirements at the organisational level for the quantification and reporting of GHG emissions and removals.

3

An annual, independent verification check of GHG data is performed using a sample-based approach.

4

Once carbon calculations have been third-party verified, operational emissions are offset through investment in the equivalent number of certified carbon credits issued by the UN.

5

Carbon emissions continue to be measured and monitored annually with carbon reduction initiatives implemented.
